What will happen when I call?

You will be asked questions about your disabling condition/s and other information that might relate to your disability case. If we're able to assist you, we'll ask you to make an appointment to come into Community Advocates for a face-to-face meeting.

What will I need to bring to my face-to-face appointment?

- Information related to your disabling condition, such as medical records or a letter from your doctor.
- Information about any prescriptions you are taking.
- Contact information for your physicians.
- Information related to your disability claim, such as proof of application and denial letters.

A Community Based Health Care Program

What is GA-MP?

The General Assistance Medical Program (GAMP) is a County and State funded program that purchases health care for qualified Milwaukee County residents. As the program has limited funds, a set of eligibility requirements has been established.

A network of providers, including thirteen community-based clinics, has been established to act as the gatekeeper for all of the services the client requires. Some of these clinics have more than one site. Services include, but are not limited to:

- primary care
- diagnostics
- pharmacist
- lab
- specialty care
- inpatient hospitalization

Unlike traditional insurance, clients do not pre-enroll for coverage. Instead, the client must be seeking services or treatment due to a medical need.

At the time of application, the person chooses the community clinic he/she would like to use for primary care. The client, if approved, must use this clinic and its network for the 6-month or 180 day eligibility period. At the end of each 6 months, the person must reapply at one of the sites or the clinic they belong to in order to determine continued eligibility. The client also has the option of remaining with the same clinic or, if preferred, choosing another one of the clinics for care.

GAMP Eligibility Requirements

As the program has limited funds, a set of qualification criteria has been established. community

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- You must have been a Milwaukee County resident for the last 180 days.
- You cannot be eligible for or on any other entitlement program (T-19 or T-18) or any third party public or private insurance.
- Social Security Number must be verifiable.
- You must meet the following income guidelines:
